This document provides instructions on the abstract preparation for the Annual Conference on Mass Spectrometry, Japan. If this is a Microsoft Word document file, you can use this file as a template of your manuscript. **The abstract should not exceed two pages including the tables, figures, and references.** The accepted abstracts will be printed in the Book of Abstracts of the annual conference. The Book of Abstract may be distributed to the conference attendees and members of the Mass Spectrometry Society for Japan (MSSJ), prior to the conference. The publication date of the Book of Abstracts may be announced in the Annual Conference Web page (accessible through <http://www.mssj.jp>).

Please use the following parameters for page set up. Margin settings: 30 mm on top, 35 mm on bottom, 30mm on right and left. Header, footer, gutter settings: Set to 0.

At the top of the first page of the manuscript, enter the title using 16-point font with a capital for the first letter of each word. Please enter the researchers' organizations with parenthesis. The superscript number typed at each organization should correspond to the number typed at the end of each author. Underline the presenting author.

Leave one blank line between the author names and "Short Abstract" lines. Please type "**Short Abstract**" and follow a short abstract of your manuscript (10 lines or less). Leave one blank line and type "**Keywords**" followed by the keywords of your choice.

The text composition area should be prepared on an A4 portrait paper or its equivalent paper with margins indicated above. The preferred typeface is Times-Roman or equivalent, in 12-point font size. The font size for superscript or subscript characters should be adjusted so that these characters will not intrude into neighboring lines. Do not use page numbers. Tables and figures must be embedded in the document. Figures should be drawn in black-and-white. **We accept electronic submission of a Microsoft Word document file (recommended) and an Adobe PDF format only.** Be sure that size of your manuscript file does not exceed 2M-bites.
